How can the entire church at Philippi continue to *stand firm*?

Chapter 1: The Philippians would <u>stand firm</u> if they rejoiced in the advance of the gospel no matter what.

Chapter 2: The Philippians would <u>stand firm</u> if they followed the pattern of joyful humility set out by others.

Chapter 3: The Philippians would <u>stand firm</u> if they really, deeply and personally experience the joy of knowing Christ.

Chapter 4: The Philippians would <u>stand firm</u> if they rejoiced in God's provision.
